HOLY WEEK/EASTER COLLECTION, CONFIRMATION INTERVIEWS, EASTER HOMEBOUND VISITS, LIFE IN THE SPIRIT SEMINAR, HEALING MASS, ARE YOU SAVED? (PART 2)



HOLY WEEK/EASTER COLLECTION: Thanks be to God, each of our Holy Day/Easter collections were increased from where they were last year. Our Holy Thursday collection was \$1006.00 (\$13.00 more than last year), our Good Friday collection was \$1,509.00 (\$713.00 more than last year) and our Easter Sunday basket collection was \$16,217.00 (\$1,700.00 more than last year) and our Online Giving was \$1,831.00 (\$275.00 more than last year). Thank you for your generous support to our parish!

CONFIRMATION INTERVIEWS: Once again this year, Fr. Steve and I are conducting confirmation interviews with each of our 8th grade students (and their parents) in both our school and CCD programs. It turns out that we have 35 Confirmation candidates altogether. Fr. Steve will have 17 interviews and I'll have 18. We enjoy meeting with the candidates to determine whether they are sufficiently prepared for this important sacrament. Please keep our students in your prayers as they prepare for this final Sacrament of Initiation (after Baptism and Holy Eucharist).

EASTER HOMEBOUND VISITS: Once again this year, Fr. Steve, Elizabeth Trexler and I will each be visiting the homebound of our parish in Monroeville and Pitcairn. Our visits will not be limited to one week but will spread out over the course of the Easter Season which ends on Pentecost Sunday, May 24th. Please keep our homebound parishioners in your prayers.

PARISH HEALTH MINISTRY TIP



Allergies can be to things ingested, in contact with, or inhaled. These allergens produce a reaction in the body from a mild reaction, such as itchy eyes, to the other end of the spectrum where a person develops a major allergic reaction with difficulty breathing or talking and possibly leading to cardiac arrest. If you have had a major reaction to something, you should write it down and carry it in your wallet, along with your current list of meds and any allergies to meds. You should also carry an Epi pen with you at all times, and use it if you have been exposed to the allergen that gave you the initial reaction. Many people also carry antihistamines with them for milder symptoms. Need to see a doctor and have no insurance? Try the Sheep clinic, open every Thursday from 6:00-8:45 PM, located at 4561 Old Wm Penn Hwy in Monroeville.

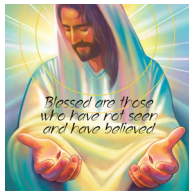
