**SPECIAL COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND, FIRST COMMUNION, DR. THERRIEN'S VISIT,  
IMMIGRATION SPEAKER, CALLED & GIFTED**



**SPECIAL COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND:** Our Parish Finance Council approved of a special collection on May 9 & 10 for extraordinary expenses in our parish. This you will find in your May church envelope package entitled "Extraordinary Expenses". We had budgeted \$7,900 for plumbing, heating and air conditioning. We have spent \$23,945 for boiler repairs at NAM church and replacement of the St. Michael Church water heater. We received a \$3,400 donation from parishioners toward this expense. We spent \$750 for a new water heater installed in the men's room of NAM Church. Altogether, we were \$21,295 over our projected budget cost for plumbing, heating and air conditioning.

Due to the harsh winter, we were \$5,000 over our projected snow removal budgeted amount of \$7,500. As you have noticed in the NAM parking lot in the area around the church, school and rectory, pot holes have sprung up. The projected cost for pothole repair is \$3,000.

We are currently \$37,500 short on our Offertory Collections. This is the money used for our daily operating costs. We are not meeting our normal daily operating commitments.

Due to the aforementioned reasons, a finance council member will be speaking at each of the Masses next weekend, after the homily, to encourage you to be generous to helping to make up for some of these deficits.

**FIRST COMMUNION:** Please remember in your prayers 35 children from our second grade (both at NAM School and in our CCD program) who will be receiving their First Holy Communion on Sunday, May 3 at 1:00 pm at North American Martyrs Church. They have been sufficiently prepared by their parents and religion teachers and have completed their interviews with Fr. Steve and me. They are very excited! I recall the words of Jesus, "Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these". (Matt.19:14)

**DR. THERRIEN'S VISIT:** Many of you picked up a copy of Pope Francis' book, The Joy of the Gospel at Christmas. Several of you commented that you have enjoyed reading it and are learning a lot more about the New Evangelization. Since our parish is one of those in which The Joy of the Gospel has been distributed, **Dr. Michel Therrien**, the Secretary for Evangelization and Catholic Education of the Diocese of Pittsburgh would like to come to speak at DeLuca Hall on Monday, May 4 from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm on "Pope Francis' Vision for the New Evangelization". This is free and open to the public. It would be helpful to have completed reading The Joy of the Gospel before coming to this seminar but it is not necessary. Whoever attends will come away with having learned more about what the Holy Father expects of us regarding "The New Evangelization".

**IMMIGRATION SPEAKER:** Mrs. Helene Paharik is an Associate General Secretary of the Diocese of Pittsburgh. She is married to James Paharik who is a Professor of Sociology at Seton Hill University. Together they have travelled to the Mid-East whose culture Jim has studied extensively. Helene will be speaking on the United States Bishops' view of the Immigration crisis in America as part of the Infant Jesus Respect Life meeting on Tuesday, May 5, at St. Michael Church at 7:45 pm (immediately after the 7:00 pm St. Anthony Novena Mass). Come and join us at the meeting to learn about the complexities of this social problem and what the bishops are recommending us to do.

**CALLED & GIFTED:** The *Called & Gifted™ Discernment Process* is a program from the Catherine of Siena Institute, Colorado Springs, Colorado, and has been used since 1993 by over 75,000 lay, ordained, and religious Catholics and other Christians around the world. The *Called & Gifted™* process is designed to help Christians discern the presence of *charisms* in their life. The cost will be \$30.00. Two speakers are flying in from across the country to present this valuable workshop.

The *Called & Gifted™* is a three part discernment process intended to help lay Catholics discern their charisms. All three parts of the process are necessary to determine where you are gifted. Part one is the Called and Gifted workshop, this workshop lays the foundation for the *beginning* of discernment. Part two is the One Hour Gifts interview, this is an invaluable part of the process. Part three, the *substance* of the discernment process. These final steps will teach you how to develop charism experiments and how to evaluate your results. The last part of this process will teach you how to identify ways you learned to control life as a child that get in the way of using your charisms as an adult.

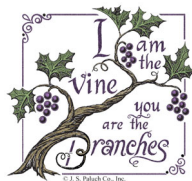

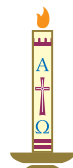
