***CORPUS CHRISTI & MONTHLY ADORATION:*** You will have two opportunities for extended Eucharistic Adoration in June. There will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Sunday, June 7 (Corpus Christi Sunday) at NAM Church immediately after the 11:00 am Mass and ending at 4:50 pm with Benediction and Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament. In addition, there will be our Monthly Eucharistic Adoration on the following day, June 8 beginning with exposition after the 8:00 am Mass and finishing with a holy hour from 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm that evening. Please take the opportunity to come to one or both times of extended adoration of our Lord to praise Him, thank Him for His blessings and to ask His intercession for your prayer requests.

***TEMPORARY CHANGE OF CONFESSIONS/ST. ANTHONY ITALIAN MASS:*** Since the Feast of St. Anthony of Padua this year falls on Saturday, June 13, I have decided to have our annual Italian Mass at St. Michael Church on that date beginning at noon with the Mass celebrated by Benedictine monk, **Fr.
