WOMEN'S GUILD GIFTS TO PARISH: Many thanks to the officers and members of the NAM Women's Guild/Christian Mothers for their gift of \$2,000.00 to our parish to help with organ repairs to the organ at NAM Church. Thanks also to their gift of \$500.00 to our school and \$500.00 to our CCD program. We really appreciate it!

INTERVIEWS FOR NEW PRINCIPAL: My search committee for our new principal consists of: **Ceil Grandillo** (former principal of St. Margaret School, Greentree and Educational Consultant of the Diocese of Pittsburgh), **Vic Maccarelli** (former principal of Gateway Junior High School, President of the NAM School Advisory Board, NAM Finance Council member), **Jennifer Speranza** (NAM school parent, former President of NAM PTG, Advancement Director for NAM School, **Tim Thorsen** (parish Business Manager), **Elizabeth Trexler** (parish Pastoral Associate), **Donna Lew-Buechel** (parish Director of Religious Education and Safe Environment Coordinator) and myself. We have had our first meeting this week and plan on interviewing candidates for the principal position on June 22 and 23. Please pray that the right candidates apply for the position and that the Holy Spirit gives our search committee discernment and wisdom to recommend the best candidate for the position to me.

PASTOR'S RETREAT I will be taking my annual priest retreat with other priests and deacons at the Franciscan University of Steubenville next week from Monday afternoon, June 15 until Saturday, June 20 and will return in time for confessions at NAM church at Noon on Saturday.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL VISITS: As recommended by **Fr. Jim Gretz** (Diocesan Director of Worship) and **Fr. Tom Kunz** (Diocesan Director of Canonical Affairs) in their parish visit here on May 11, I travelled with a group of **four women**, (two from our parish and two from neighboring parishes) to visit three parish Eucharistic Adoration Chapels on Tuesday, June 9th. We visited chapels at: St. Thomas More, Bethel Park, Mary, Mother of Hope, New Castle and St. Michael the Archangel, Butler and took careful notes. The architect, **Luke Desmone**, hopes to do the same with his staff very soon. We will then compare notes as I make my second recommendation for the Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Chapel to **Fr. Larry DiNardo**, Diocesan General Secretary. Fr. DiNardo has given permission for a schematic and conceptual design of the chapel but recommends a different location of the chapel on our campus. **Tim Thorsen**, myself and the four ladies looked at an alternate location on our campus that we prefer and which better meets the requirements for constructing a Perpetual Eucharistic Chapel. I will share more information in the future as I learn more. Once approved, this chapel will be the only Perpetual Eucharistic Chapel on this side of the Squirrel Hill Tunnels (except for the Ryan Newman Center on the Oakland campus). This chapel will serve the needs not only of our parishioners but the needs of other parishioners in the Eastern suburbs. Please pray that it comes about.

"OUR MISSION FOR THE CHURCH ALIVE" HOLY HOUR: On Wednesday, June 24 at 7:00 pm at North American Martyrs Church, we will be one of 12 parishes throughout the diocese having a Holy Hour and Guided Meditation simultaneously on June 24. A member of the Diocesan Pastoral Staff will be joining us as well as members of various parishes in our area. The prayer is for unity as parishes throughout the diocese begin the process of praying for parishes in clusters for greater sharing of resources and envisioning creative ways of working together. Please come and join us for this special night of praying with people from other parishes.
