Please pray for her as she makes the transition from teaching in the classroom to being principal. I am confident that she will serve our school very well in the footsteps of her predecessor, Mrs. Diane Fleet.

THANKS TO ALL OF OUR FESTIVAL VOLUNTEERS: Even though at the time of this writing, our Summer Festival has not yet begun, I would like to thank **Nick Oto** and our Parish staff, School staff, the Festival Captains and all of the festival volunteers for your part in ensuring another successful festival. A special thanks goes to Mary Jane Petrilli for “shadowing” Nick to guide him as he has taken on the chairmanship for our NAM Parish Festival for the first time. It takes a great deal of preparation to organize, coordinate and implement a parish festival. It involves not only our parish but the community at large, since there are many sponsors from the community as well as vendors who pay a set fee and then keep the proceeds of what they sell. It involves advertisement, soliciting sponsors, advance ticket sales of raffle tickets and ride tickets. It involves the ordering of supplies including food and beverage, paper products, games, prizes and the movement of chairs/tables and electric power connections. It involves advance food preparation and the renting of amusement rides, festival stands, tents, inflatables as well as contractual agreements with musical artists. It involves set-up, clean-up and breakdown. In fact, there have been ongoing meetings throughout the year to prepare for our festival week. Thanks to all of you who, in any way, supported our Parish Festival this year. May God continue to bless you throughout the summer so that you may enjoy it while we have it!

CHURCH ALIVE UPDATE: Currently, the Diocesan Legal Office has approved of the contracts between architect, **Luke Desmone**, and North American Martyrs Parish for the beginning of phase one i.e. for the architect to provide the conceptual and schematic drawings for both the school renovation and the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel. After Mr. Desmone is done with his drawings, he will ask permission from the Municipality of Monroeville for permission to build. Once he gives his blueprints to each of the three parish contractors who are interested in this project, they will present bids to me for being the contractor for both projects. Once I select a contractor based upon the lowest bid, I will submit the proposal to our Regional Vicar, Very Rev. Frederick Cain which must then be approved by the “Please Advise” Board of the bishop before work can begin. Hopefully, the construction process will begin before the end of the summer and will continue into the fall. School will begin on August 24 as we all work “around the construction schedule” with minimal disruption to the teachers and students.

In the meantime, for those of you who have pledged money for the Church Alive Program, thank you for making your payments. Some have been very diligent, others are lagging behind. As of now, we have about \$148,000 in our Church Alive Account which began in September through December of 2013 and continues until September through December of 2018. Please be faithful to your Church Alive Payments—we are counting on you!

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION: Our next scheduled day of Eucharistic Adoration will be this Monday, July 13 with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after the 8:00 am Mass and will continue all day concluding with a holy hour from 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Come and worship the Lord with us!

ATTENTION ALL PARISH ORGANIZATION LEADERS

This is the time of year to schedule your group's meetings and events for 2015-2016. Your organization may depend on using our facilities for certain dates, but unless those dates are reserved on our calendar, you may run the risk of losing them. You must either pick up a form or request the forms by email to schedule now with the parish secretary for your meetings and events taking place between the months of August, 2015 and July, 2016. Please try to set your dates as soon as possible.

PROPERTY TAX/RENT REBATE PROGRAM

The deadline to apply to the state's Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program for a rebate on property taxes or rent paid in 2014 has been extended from **June 30 until December 31, 2015.**

The program benefits eligible Pennsylvanians 65 or older, widows and widowers 50 or older, and people with disabilities 18 or older. The income limit is \$35,000 a year for homeowners and \$15,000 annually for renters. Half of Social Security income and all COLAs are excluded, and the maximum standard rebate is \$650.

Claimants must reapply for rebates every year because they are based on annual income and property taxes or rent paid each year. Spouses, personal representatives or estates may file rebate claims on behalf of deceased claimants who lived at least one day in 2014 and meet all other eligibility criteria.

Please contact my office with questions about the application or stop by for assistance completing the form. My staff can let you know what paperwork you need to apply. If you have already applied to the program, rebates have begun to be distributed as of Wednesday, **July 1.**

Some companies are running ads offering to do the paperwork for this state program and charge a fee, but you do not have to pay for this help. If you don't think you're eligible, please feel free to pass this message on to a relative, friend or neighbor. ~ **Rep. Joseph F. Markosek, D-25th District, Allegheny County.**

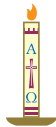
