***POTHOLE REPAIR, BECOME A FOSTER PARENT! HIDDEN DANGERS OF YOGA,  
MEN'S RETREAT IN SEPTEMBER***

**POTHOLE REPAIR:** You may have noticed that the potholes around the North American Martyrs Church campus have been repaired on July 21st and 22nd by a company called **Quality Asphalt**. This included repairing 13 areas including nine major areas. In addition they elevated the exit ramp ground level to avoid water pooling in the future. The total cost was \$3,870 which has come out of our Building and Maintenance Fund.

**BECOME A FOSTER PARENT!** **Holly Joy McIlwain**, Associate Diocesan Director of the Department of Youth and Young Adult Ministry, wrote to all pastors to encourage them to promote Auberle Foster Care. Holly Joy learned from the Director of Auberle that there is a need for foster homes for over 150 high school aged youth who are at risk of being displaced and disrupting their schooling. Because of Holly Joy's work for the past 15 years with high school youth, it broke her heart to think that these young people might be going through such difficult home situations without the support of a loving family and faith community to surround them.

**Auberle** has been named an **Agency of the Year in the United States**. Auberle is where life changes for kids and families. They recognize that child abuse, neglect and other traumatic events can lead to a multitude of health and social challenges. To counteract the effect of trauma on the individuals they serve, Auberle embraces The Sanctuary Model of Trauma-Informed Care. Creating Sanctuary is the process of providing a safe and healing environment for individuals who need to recover from adverse childhood experiences. All of Auberle's programs and services provide care through a trauma-informed lens. Check out the flyer in today's bulletin for more information.

**HIDDEN DANGERS OF YOGA:** Many health clubs offer Yoga classes which have certainly been embraced by our culture and have been around for some time. In casual conversation with our Pastoral Associate, **Elizabeth Trexler**, a few months ago, she mentioned that there is no such thing as "Christian Yoga" due to the close alliance between Yoga and Hinduism. Even for those who "just do the exercises" and "don't pray to any Hindu gods" the evidence would indicate the contrary. Apparently, the body positions of yoga call upon Hindu gods and were used to pay homage to Hindu gods. This means that even if you don't want to worship a Hindu god but are in the Hindu body position, it is seen as an act of Hindu worship. This comes from an article by Laurette Willis who was a yoga instructor for 22 years. At my request, Elizabeth Trexler contacted parishioner, **Mary Ann Haslett** who is a "Praise Moves" instructor who provides a Christian exercise alternative to yoga.
