LOOKING BACK: What Has Been Accomplished So Far?

Summer 2016 - 12 Summer Sessions attended by **thousands of faithful** across the Diocese.

Fall 2016 - Draft Parish Models presented at **329 consultation sessions**.

Winter 2016 - 30,000+ pieces of feedback about models considered.

Spring 2017 - 49 Proposed Parish Groupings* presented and feedback received.

**A Parish Grouping is a proposed configuration of parishes that in the coming years will form a new parish community. Final groupings will be announced in Spring 2018 and will be the result of feedback provided by the parishes.*

CURRENT EVENTS: What Is Happening Now?

The *On Mission Commission* and its **Steering Committees**, a group of **80 clergy, religious and lay faithful** from across the Diocese of Pittsburgh, are **studying** the feedback on the **Proposed Parish Groupings**.

Over the **coming months** they will **make recommendations** to Bishop Zubik. While Bishop Zubik will make the **final decisions**, the work of the commission will **inform the Bishop's decision-making**.
